Look at John 1:29, 1 Corinthians 5:6-8, 1 Peter 1:18-19 and Revelation 5:6-14 How does passover point towards the rescue that Jesus brings ?

In the exodus story God says he is bringing judgement on the Gods of Egypt. What kind of Gods might we have ?

The redemption story in Exodus isn't about individuals but communities. It's the first place where Redemption comes up in the Bible. What difference is there in thinking of ourselves as a redeemed community (Titus 2:14, Rev 1:5-6) ?
