## **Reading Exodus 12:1-13,29-32**

Have you ever had a pet lamb? What was it like? What was it's name?

Why do you think God asked the Israelites to stain their doorways with blood?

What kinds of choices do we make that mark us as followers of Jesus?

What's the difference between a sacrifice that is distant and one that is close? Why do you think the family was to look after the lamb at home?

Look at John 1:29, 1 Corinthiasn 5:6-8, 1 Peter 1:18-19 and Revelation 5:6-14 How does passover point towards the rescue that Jesus brings?

In the exodus story God says he is bringing judgement on the God's of Egypt. What kind of Gods might we have?

The redemption story in Exodus isn't about individuals but communities. It's the first place where Redemption comes up in the Bible. What difference is there in thinking of ourselves as a redeemed community (Titus 2:14, Rev 1:5-6)?
