- Strong biblical teaching skills and a passion for prayer and God's Word.
- Collaborative and strategic leadership abilities.
- Ability to motivate, equip, and nurture the church community through preaching, teaching, and spiritual counselling.
- Experienced in facilitating healthy relationships within the church community.
- Someone who is experienced in developing effective teams and encouraging others to develop their gifts and skills.
- Relevant tertiary training (preferably degree level from a theological college).
- Aligned with the core theological and missional beliefs of Parklands Baptist Community Church, as outlined in our Constitution.
- Understanding and adherence to the Baptist Statement of Faith, protocols, and practices.

Other items of note

- The applicant must be currently registered with the Baptist Union or actively pursuing such registration. Registration includes a commitment to regular supervision.
- Active participation in an annual review process to evaluate the pastor's ministry and leadership is mandatory.
- Must be a New Zealand citizen or hold New Zealand residency.
- Requirement to comply with necessary administrative procedures.
- 0.8 1.0 FTE (negotiable). Remuneration is based on NZ Baptist Union recommendations.
